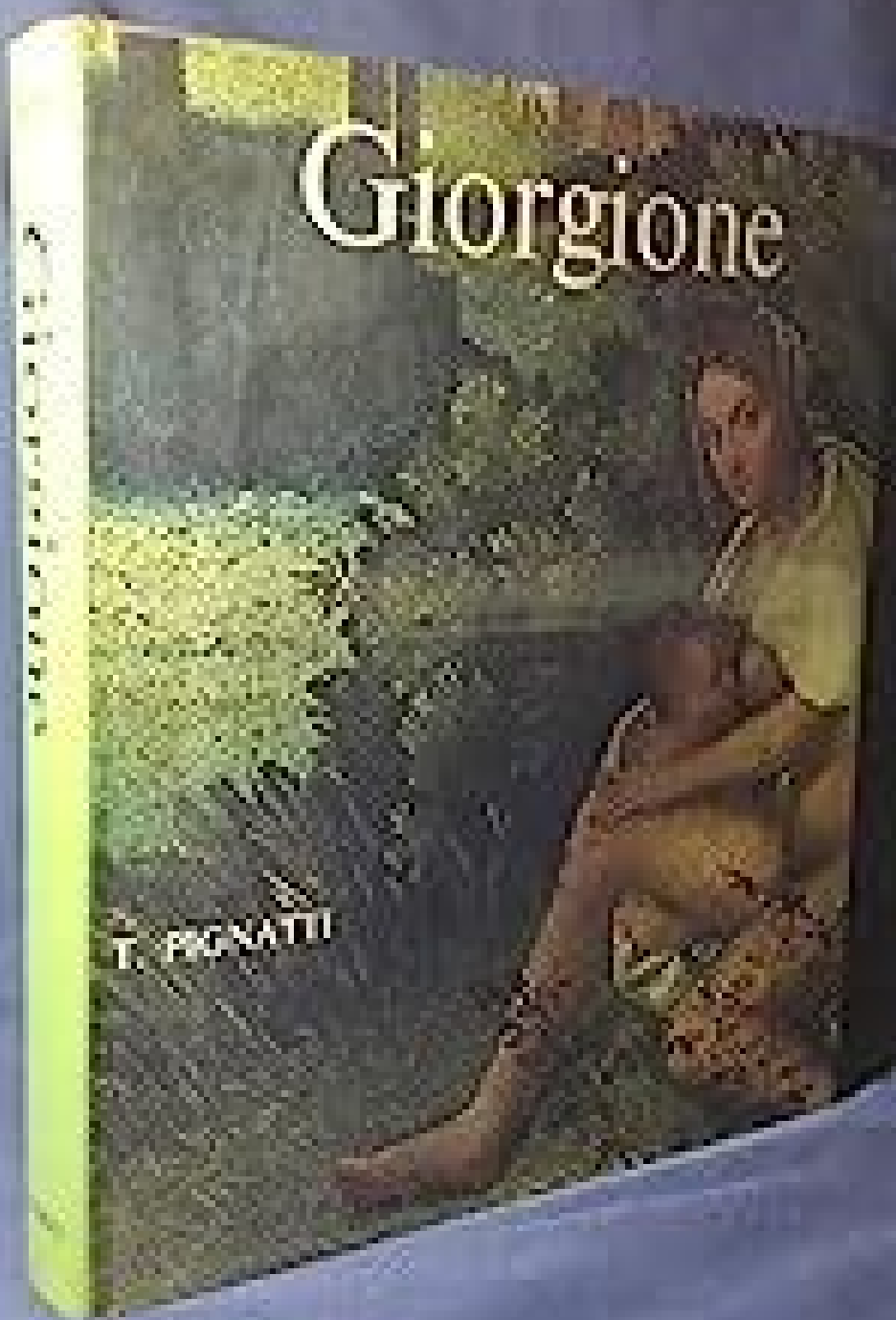

B. Bullen, 2005-08-25 Continental Crosscurrents is a series of case studies reflecting British attitudes to continental art during the nineteenth and the early twentieth centuries It stresses the way in which the British went to the continent in their search for origins or their pursuit of sources of purity and originality This cult of the primitive took many forms it involved a reassessment of medieval German and Italian art and offered new ways of interpreting Venetian painting it opened up new readings of architectural history and the discovery of the Romanesque it generated a debate about the value of returning to religious subjects in art and it raised the question of the relationship between modern art and Byzantine art in the early twentieth century J B Bullen's original study presents some exciting findings Few critics have noticed how much in advance of his time was Coleridge's passion for medieval art Ruskin's debt in the *Stones of Venice* to Victor Hugo's *Notre Dame de Paris* has hardly been noted and Browning's involvement with the debate on the morality of Christian art is explored more extensively than previously Three chapters are devoted to the role of British criticism in identifying the Romanesque style in architecture and differentiating it from the Gothic They trace the concept as it arose in criticism at the beginning of the nineteenth century its employment in the remarkable buildings of Edmund Sharpe and Sara Losh and the way in which it reached a climax in Waterhouse's enigmatic choice of Romanesque for the Natural History Museum in London The collection concludes with two continental episodes from the history of modernism One is the explosive British reaction to the primitivism of Gauguin the other involves the identifying of one of the characters in D H Lawrence's novel *Women in Love* Curious evidence suggests that the malevolent figure of Loerke was based on a German sculptor whom Lawrence met in Italy before the First World War *Brunelleschi's Egg* Mary D. Garrard, 2010 Garrard one of a small handful of truly distinguished feminist art historians presents a detailed and visually convincing account of the relationship between nature and art in all its fraught and gendered cultural meaning

Venice Martin Gayford, 2023-10-05 Venice was a major centre of art in the Renaissance the city where the medium of oil on canvas became the norm The achievements of the Bellini brothers Carpaccio Giorgione Titian Tintoretto and Veronese are a key part of this story Nowhere else has been depicted by so many great painters in so many diverse styles and moods Venetian views were a speciality of native artists such as Canaletto and Guardi but the city has also been represented by outsiders J M W Turner Claude Monet John Singer Sargent Howard Hodgkin and many more Then there are those who came to look at and write about art The reactions of Henry James George Eliot Richard Wagner and others enrich this tale Nor is the story over Since the advent of the Venice Biennale in the 1890s and the arrival of pioneering modern art collector Peggy Guggenheim in the late 1940s the city has become a shop window for the contemporary art of the whole world and it remains the site of important artistic events In this elegant volume Gayford who has visited Venice countless times since the 1970s covered every Biennale since 1990 and even had portraits of himself exhibited there on

several occasions takes us on a visual journey through the past five centuries of the city known La Serenissima the Most Serene It is a unique and compelling portrait of Venice that will delight lovers of the city and lovers of its art *Giorgione's Ambiguity* Tom Nichols,2020-10-17 The Venetian painter known as Giorgione or big George died at a young age in the dreadful plague of 1510 possibly having painted fewer than twenty five works But many of these are among the most mysterious and alluring in the history of art Paintings such as *The Three Philosophers* and *The Tempest* remain compellingly elusive seeming to deny the viewer the possibility of interpreting their meaning Tom Nichols argues that this visual elusiveness was essential to Giorgione's sensual approach and that ambiguity is the defining quality of his art Through detailed discussions of all Giorgione's works Nichols shows that by abandoning the more intellectual tendencies of much Renaissance art Giorgione made the world and its meanings appear always more inscrutable "Titian, Colonna and the Renaissance Science of Procreation" Anthony Colantuono,2017-07-05 Titian Colonna and the Renaissance Science of Procreation demonstrates that two major monuments of Italian Renaissance culture Bellini's and Titian's famous series of mytho-poetical paintings for the camerino of Duke Alfonso d'Este of Ferrara and Francesco Colonna's *Hypnerotomachia Poliphili* were conceived as mnemonic or pedagogical devices aimed at educating the reader beholder in the medical science of reproductive physiology and the maintenance of sexual health It is further argued that the learned courtier Mario Equicola who conceived the pictorial program of Duke Alfonso's camerino had read Colonna's text and was extensively inspired by its prior literary argument The study is organized in two parts intimately interrelated The first part is a study of Alfonso d'Este's camerino with a general introduction individual chapters on each of Bellini's and Titian's four pictorial bacchanals and a conclusion proposing a new and more accurate reconstruction of the layout of the room also including a completely new way of interpreting the ensemble The second part of the study concerns Colonna's *Hypnerotomachia Poliphili* again beginning with its own introductory essay and advancing a completely new interpretation of the text The brief conclusion brings the insights of the two sections together clarifying the historical relationship between the pictorial and literary works and explaining their larger cultural significance Emphasizing Equicola's use of the *Hypnerotomachia* as a model for pictorial invention the author reveals how Titian's remarkably sensuous paintings and Colonna's erotically charged romance are related by their common reference to the neo-Aristotelian medical theory of the libidinal seasons and by corollary themes of marriage and sexual consummation This peculiar intersection of cultural themes came to prominence in the context of a courtly world in which medical science was increasingly brought to bear on the problem of dy **Albrecht Dürer** David Ekserdjian,2023-07-25 An exploration of the life and works of German artist Albrecht Dürer and his self-obsession The Italian Renaissance birthed the modern sense of self and no artist from the period compares with Albrecht Dürer 1471-1528 in terms of the almost obsessive interest he displayed in his own life Dürer's works are filled with personal details from his day-to-day his dreams and his escapades In this brief biography David Ekserdjian explores Dürer's life and times his studies travels and

Giorgio Vasari Patricia Lee Rubin,Maurice Rubin,1995-01-01 Vasari s Lives of the Painters Sculptors and Architects are and always have been central texts for the study of the Italian Renaissance They can and should be read in many ways Since their publication in the mid sixteenth century they have been a source of both information and pleasure Their immediacy after more than four hundred years is a measure of Vasari s success He wished the artists of his day himself included to be famous He made the association of artistry and genius of renaissance and the arts so familiar that they now seem inevitable In this book Patricia Rubin argues that both the inevitability and the immediacy should be questioned To read Vasari without historical perspective results in a limited and distorted view of The Lives Rubin shows that Vasari had distinct ideas about the nature of his task as a biographer about the importance of interpretation judgment and example about the historian s art Vasari s principles and practices as a writer are examined here as are their sources in Vasari s experiences as an artist
