Foul Perfection Mike Kelley, 2003-06-20 Critical writings and commentary by the Los Angeles based artist Mike Kelley. The work of artist Mike Kelley b 1954 embraces performance installation drawing painting video and sculpture. Drawing distinctively on high art and vernacular traditions including historical research popular culture and psychology Kelley came to prominence in the 1980s with a series of sculptures composed of craft materials. His recent work offers dialogues with architecture and with repressed memory syndrome and a sustained inquiry into his own aesthetic and social history. The subjects on which Kelley has written are as varied as his artistic media. They include the work of fellow artists sound caricature the uncanny UFOlogy and gender bending. This book offers a diverse collection of Kelley's writings from the last twenty five years. It contains major critical texts on art film and the wider culture including his piece on the aesthetic he calls urban Gothic. It also contains essays mostly commissioned for exhibition catalogs and journals on the artists and groups David Askevold yvind Fahlstr m Douglas Huebler John Miller Survival Research Laboratories and Paul Thek among others. John Miller, 2015-01-30 An illustrated examination of a 1995 work by Mike Kelley that marked a significant change in his work. One of the most influential artists of our time Mike Kelley 1954 2012 produced a body of innovative work mining American popular culture as well as modernist and postmodernist art relentless examinations of subjectivity and of society that are both sinister and ecstatic. With a wide range of media Kelley's work explores themes as varied as post punk politics religious systems social class and repressed memory. Using architectural models to represent schools he attended his 1995 work Educational Complex presents forgotten spaces as frames for private trauma real or imagined. The work's implications are at once miniature and massive. In this book John Miller offers an illustrated examination of this milestone work that marked a significant change in Kelley's practice. A complex can mean an architectural configuration a psychological syndrome or a political apparatus and Miller approaches Educational Complex through corresponding lines of inquiry considering the making of the work examining it in terms of education and trauma sexual or otherwise and investigating how it tests the ideological horizon of art as an institution. Miller shows that in Educational Complex Kelley expands his political and aesthetic focus including not only such artifacts as generic forms of architecture but inspired by the infamous McMartin Preschool case popular fantasies associated with ritual sex abuse and false memory syndrome. The Spectacle of Terror in Post War Europe Gianfranco Sanguinetti, John Barker, Charity Scribner, Tom Vague, 2015-07-13 This collection brings together a spread of writers revolutionaries and reprobates to offer up a variety of critical perspectives on key European armed struggle groups from the 1970 s Gianfranco Sanguinetti founding member of the Italian Section of the Situationist International writes in On Terrorism and the State 1978 Italian terrorism is the last enigma of the society of the spectacle and only those who reason dialectically can solve it Today all those who speak of social revolution without denouncing and combating the terrorist counter revolution have a corpse in their mouths Dave and Stuart Wise King Mob look into the relationship between the Italian Communist Party workers struggles post 68 and the roots of the Red Brigades concluding of the latter they added to the substitutionism of Lenin who replaced the proletariat by the Party by replacing the Party with the armed struggle Prof Charity Scribner MIT contributes Buildings on Fire The Situationist International and the Red Army Faction exploring how and why the SI and the RAF s differing definitions of autonomy produced divergent modes of resistance Both the RAF and the Situationists drew from the arsenals of anarchism and Marxism But whereas Debord critiqued the society of the spectacle the leaders of the RAF became fodder for the media machine leaving a legacy heavy on style but light on political analysis Tom Vague contributes fast paced potted histories of the RAF and Angry Brigade both strong on time line energy both useful entry level introductions to the respective narratives John Barker was sentenced to ten years at the Old Bailey in 1972 for his Angry Brigade activities they framed a guilty man and here he laments Tom Vague s fetishisation of the Angry Brigade and how comfortable he is with the situationist angle while saying nothing about the analysis and theory that came out of the Italian movement from Potere Operaio onwards which was more important to us Barker s piece dated from the late 1990 s goes on to give a brief but uniquely frank first person perspective on the AB s activities viewed through the prism of realism maturity and continued belief in the revolutionary potential of mass working class action over the clandestine substitutionist activities of the few a fitting end to this book

Minor Histories Mike Kelley, 2004-02-06 The second volume of writings by Los Angeles artist Mike Kelley focusing on his own work What John C Welchman calls the blazing network of focused confluences from which Mike Kelley s styles are generated is on display in all its diversity in this second volume of the artist s writings The first volume Foul

Influential writings by the legendary art critic and theorist Jack Burnham a pioneer in new media systems aesthetics and an early advocate of conceptualism Jack Burnham is one of the few critics and theorists alive today who can claim to have radically altered the way we think about works of art Burnham s use of the term system borrowed from theoretical biology in his 1968 essay System Aesthetics announced the relational character of conceptual art and newer research based projects Trained as an art historian Burnham was also a sculptor His first book Beyond Modern Sculpture 1968 established him as a leading commentator on art and technology A postformalist pioneer an influential figure in new media art history an early champion of conceptual and ecological art and the curator of the first exhibition of digital art Burnham is long overdue for reevaluation This book offers that opportunity by collecting a substantial and varied selection of his hard to find texts some published here for the first time Although Burnham left the art world abruptly in the 1990s his visionary theoretical ideas have only become more relevant in recent years This collection seeks to restore Burnham to his rightful place in art criticism and theory reestablishing his voice as crucial to critical conversations of the period It gathers his early writing on sculpture his essays on systems art and conceptualism his views of the New York art world and his later occult work including an unorthodox interpretation of Marcel Duchamp s work that draws on the Kabbalah **Ai Weiwei's Blog** Ai

Weiwei,2011-03-18 Manifestos and immodest proposals from China s most famous artist and activist culled from his popular blog shut down by Chinese authorities in 2009 In 2006 even though he could barely type China s most famous artist started blogging For more than three years Ai Weiwei turned out a steady stream of scathing social commentary criticism of government policy thoughts on art and architecture and autobiographical writings He wrote about the Sichuan earthquake

Language to Cover a Page Vito Acconci, 2006 Poems and other texts from the 1960s by a pioneering conceptual artist that show a continuity with his subsequent work in performance and video art Pioneering conceptual artist Vito Acconci began his career as a poet In the 1960s before beginning his work in performance and video art Acconci studied at the Iowa Writers Workshop and published poems in journals and chapbooks Almost all of this work remains unknown much of it appeared in the self produced magazines of the Lower East Side s mimeo revolution and many other pieces were never published Language to Cover a Page collects these writings for the first time

and not only shows Acconci to be an important experimental writer of the period but demonstrates the continuity of his early writing with his later work in film video and performance Language to Cover a Page documents a key moment in the unprecedented intersection of artists and poets in the late 1960s as seen in the Dwan Gallery's series of Language shows 1967-1970 and in Acconci's own journal 0 to 9 Indeed as Acconci moved from the poetry scene to the art world his poetry became increasingly performative while his artwork was often structured and motivated by linguistic play Acconci's early writing recalls the work of Samuel Beckett the deadpan voice of the nouveau roman and the jump cuts and fraught permutations of the nouvelle vague Poems in Language to Cover a Page explore the materiality of language language as matter and not ideas as Robert Smithson put it the physical space of the page and the physicality of source texts phonebooks thesauruses dictionaries Other poems take the space of the page as an analogue to performance space or implicate the poem in a network of activity as in his Dial a Poem pieces Readers will find Acconci's inventive and accomplished poetry as edgy and provocative as anything published today
