Feierstein genocide can be considered a technology of power a form of social engineering that creates destroys or reorganizes relationships within a given society It influences the ways in which different social groups construct their identity and the identity of others thus shaping the way that groups interrelate Feierstein establishes continuity between the reorganizing genocide first practiced by the Nazis in concentration camps and the more complex version complex in terms of the symbolic and material closure of social relationships later applied in Argentina In conclusion he speculates on how to construct a political culture capable of confronting and resisting these trends First published in Argentina in Spanish *Genocide as Social Practice* has since been translated into many languages now including this English edition The book provides a distinctive and valuable look at genocide through the lens of Latin America as well as Europe
