come from 12 different countries that vary in perceived cultural distance from Sweden. The findings suggest that identifications with older age and migrancy seem to be dynamic and flexible rather than necessarily permanently meaningful, thus gaining meaning in specific situations and in relation to particular Others. External definitions furthermore do not always seem to match with internal ones. Regardless of how older age and migrancy are constructed, they seem to be negotiable. This dissertation thus contributes to identity research by studying older age and migrancy together and furthermore sheds light onto how the social constructionist lens allows us to see variability where stability otherwise would be presumed.
