How are you? I pray that this letter will find you feeling well along with your family and friends.

For me I am doing about as well as I can God, gives me the strength to remain strong in my time of need for which I am very thankful.

I am writing with the hope that I can get your help, I read the story that you wrote on Ray Jasper, early this year I think it was in March, what a good story well I am in the same situation I am on death row in Texas and the state will set me another execution date on the 7, of Nov. please allow me to give you some background on April 23, 2003 I was given a stay of execution on the mental retardation issue when I was 13 years old and in state custody Gatesville State School for Boys, this was in 1974 I am now 57 years old when I was a child/teenager I got into alot of trouble and I couldn't do good^{at} school doing one of my trip to state school I saw a doctor who wrote in my records that I was mild to moderate mentally retarded he also gave me afew IQ test and I made a 67 which is in the records, I was given a stay of execution on this info, I was given a hearing where I put on even more evidence like my sister telling the court about when we was child how I had a hard time playing games like kick ball and how our mother would send me to the store and I would come back with the wrong items, My anut told the hearing that my mother use to drink whiskey when she was carrying my lawyers never called an expert on the subject.

And in 1995 Or 96 when I got out of prison I was given a job at a place call the Andrews Center in Tyler Texas once I got there I saw that it was a place for mentally retarded workers I didn't think much of it I was given the job I work there for afew years until I got this case, and came to death row this is when I found out that I was being treated as a mentally retarded client I was given a service coordnator, my money was kept in the trust fund, I was helped with housing, and the coordinator would take me shopping because I had a hard time managing my money the suprevisor Al Matson, testified to all of this at the hearing now MOST IMPORTANT HE ALSO TESTIFIED THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR ALLOWS MENTALLY RETARDED CENTERS, LIKE THE ANDREWS CENTER, TO PAY LESS THAN MINIMUM

Dennis My Friend on Death Row Jan Tystad,2019-11-25 The Norwegian journalist and author Jan Tystad tells in this book about his American pen friend who has been on Death Row in Florida for 33 years The prisoner tells in his letters how it feels to be isolated for so many years and how he has been helped by listening to music player and follow the news and documentaries on TV Dennis has showed an unbelievable strength in such an environment helped very much by classic music which he can listen to for hours He has also developed great knowledge about the world and the politicians who runs it by listening to news and documentaries on his small TV in the cell Dennis is only allowed out of the cell for five hours a week to walk in the forecourt He finds happiness and friendship in letter writing and fight every day to prevent that the death sentence is executed He hope that the governor of Florida will change the sentence to life prisonment which would mean that he will be a free man the life sentence is 25 years in Florida

revenge in 36 of the US states a process directly in violation of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights A process currently viewed by 88% of American Criminologists and by most American police chiefs as the least effective deterrent to violent crime one that costs 114 million more annually than life imprisonment in one state alone Since the year 2000 almost 700 people have been executed in the 36 states that still enforce the death penalty in the US In Condemned after several years of writing to Ray Riain makes us question the prevalence of the death sentence in the American legal system and asks should any state punish the death of a citizen with more death
