Few people would disagree with the statement that favorable reports about Haiti are as rare as positive declarations on the nutritional value of cannibalism or the healing power of black magic. In the 1960s the eminent anthropological scholar of the Caribbean, Sidney Mintz, remarked, "Few countries in modern times have received as bad a press at the hands of foreign observers as Haiti." In the 1970s another anthropologist, who specializes in studying Haiti, complained, "Haiti still has a uniquely poor press as New World societies go." In the 1980s still another anthropologist, who conducted a detailed survey of magazines in the United States, came to the same conclusion. And this situation continues into the present.

In fact, most of the works on Haiti that the public reads are based on

myths, most of which are, at best, uninformed and plagiaristic and, at worst, mean-spirited and narrow-minded. These myths are intimately connected with broader forms of rac-
