Landmines And Unexploded Ordnance Rae McGrath, 2000-03-20 Describes the resiliance of African traditional farming practices in resisting the imposition of Western development schemes by powerful elites When the Bombs Stopped Erin Lin, 2024-05-21 How undetonated bombs from a war that ended more than fifty years ago still affect Cambodian farmers and their land Over the course of the Vietnam War the United States dropped 500 000 tons of bombs over Cambodia more than the combined weight of every man woman and child in the country What began as a secret CIA infiltration of Laos eventually expanded into Cambodia and escalated into a nine year war over the Ho Chi Minh trail fought primarily with bombs Fifty years after the last sortie residents of rural Cambodia are still coping with the unexploded ordnance that covers their land In When the Bombs Stopped Erin Lin investigates the consequences of the US bombing campaign across postconflict Cambodia Drawing on interviews original econometric analysis and extensive fieldwork Lin upends the usual scholarly perspective on the war and its aftermath presenting the viewpoint of those who suffered the bombing rather than those who dropped the bombs She shows that Cambodian farmers stay at a subsistence level because much of their land is too dangerous to cultivate and yet paradoxically the same bombs that endanger and impoverish farming communities also protect them deterring predatory elites from grabbing and commodifying their land Lin argues that the half century legacy of American bombs has sedimented the war into the layers of contemporary Cambodian society Policies aimed at developing or modernizing Cambodia whether economic liberalization or authoritarian consolidation must be realized in an environment haunted by the violence of the past As the stories Lin captures show the bombing served as a critical juncture in these farming villages marking the place in time where development stopped Doing Their Bit Kimberly Brice O'Donnell,2019-05-08 The first in depth study of the role of canines in WWII Britain an important but hitherto under represented subject with photos included Society of Army Historical Research The Second World War allowed for the use of an unprecedented number of dogs for military duties both internationally and among the British Armed Forces On the British Home Front civilians responded to calls from the British Army s War Dogs Training School and the Ministry of Aircraft Production Guard Dog Training School by donating their canine pets for military training and employment for the duration As dogs were instructed in roles with the British Army the Royal Air Force and the London Civil Defence Region the distinction between pet and trained working animal became increasingly unclear While civilians and servicemen alike continued to view military dogs as pets many also saw trained canines as human like soldiers doing their bit a depiction promulgated by both the military and the wartime press Yet historians have paid little attention to the subject In the first comprehensive scholarly account of the employment of British military and Civil Defence dogs in the Second World War Kimberly Brice O Donnell traces the story from the belated establishment of the short lived War Dog School and the Messenger Dog Service of the First World War to the more recent employment of canines in Iraq and Afghanistan With a focus on WWII Doing their Bit examines
