

species is fertile enough that if all offspring survived to reproduce the population would grow fact Despite periodic fluctuations populations remain roughly the same size fact Resources such as food are limited and are relatively stable over time fact A struggle for survival ensues inference Individuals in a population vary significantly from one another fact Much of this variation is inheritable fact Individuals less suited to the environment are less likely to survive and less likely to reproduce individuals more suited to the environment are more likely to survive and more likely to reproduce and leave their inheritable traits to future generations which produces the process of natural selection inference This slowly effected process results in populations changing to adapt to their environments and ultimately these variations accumulate over time to form new species inference
