in Karl Popper's *The Open Society and Its Enemies* Swartz has also been significantly influenced by the educational writings of Bertrand Russell and Paul Goodman Goodman's *Compulsory Miseducation* makes it clear that schools which follow in the tradition of Summerhill compete with the educational programs that are an outgrowth of John Dewey's writings In summary Swartz's book aims to engage educators in dialogues that will lead to improved educational theories and practices
