The efforts of the authors involved so many community people: from historians, preservationists, librarians, textile historians, local historians, museum curators, and genealogists to quilt guild members, quilt shop owners, and quilt owners, making *Alabama Quilts* not only a celebration of the quilting culture within the state but also the many enthusiasts who have played a role in creating and sustaining this important art.
