The Old and the New: Churching a Secular Age from Solovyov to Bulgakov Michael Lee Miller, 2025-03-25 In the midst of exile from his native Russia in the mid 1930s Fr Sergii Bulgakov identified his basic aspiration as an Orthodox theologian to be a positive overcoming of Modernity in fact a continuation of the efforts of his great 19th century inspiration Vladimir Solovyev to reconstruct Christian thought and culture in the face of the unprecedented challenges posed by the Enlightenment and the era of revolutionary upheaval But Bulgakov's theological vision also involves a distinctive revision of Solovyev's programme whose residual Hegelianism continually threatens to level out speculative reason and mystagogical faith progress in history and the Kingdom not of this World Bulgakov refuses any such levelling instead he consummates the apocalyptic turn Solovyev had already commenced in the years immediately preceding his premature death in 1900 The resulting preference for the paradox of antinomy over the closure of dialectic comes to light in relation to four themes running through Bulgakov's thinking in the decades falling between his rejection of Marxism and the commencement of his mature systematic theological work in the 1930s history work knowledge and power

pocos meses a modo de homenaje y replica Volkening le presenta Gómez Dávila los cinco cuadernos en que transcribió y comentó los escolios que despertaron con más fuerza su interés. Ahora cuando ya toca a su fin el hermoso viaje que me fue permitido hacer en su compañía me pregunto qué pueda decirle para traducir en términos sinceros justos y adecuados mi íntima convicción de haberle dado un opus magnum.
