ANTON Charles Pegis was born 14 August 1905 in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, U.S.A., the child of Costas and Euphrosyne Pegis. He received his B.A. in 1928 and his M.A. in 1929 from Marquette University in Milwaukee and his Ph.D. in Philosophy in 1931 from the University of Toronto. He was one of the first graduate students in Toronto to carry on his research in the newly organized Institute of Mediaeval Studies where he worked under the direction of Rosamond Gilson and Gerald Phelan. His doctoral dissertation, *The Problem of the Soul in the 13th Century*, was published in 1934 by the Institute in St. Michael's College Mediaeval Studies.

Dr. Pegis began his teaching career in the department of Philosophy, Marquette University, in 1931, transferring to Fordham University, New York in 1932. From 1934 until April 1935 he was special visiting lecturer at Marquette with which he always maintained close associations. He was honoured by Marquette with an honorary L.L.D. in 1936 and with the Alumni Merit Award in 1937.

In 1944 Dr. Pegis joined the staff of the Pontifical Institute of Mediaeval Studies, Toronto, where he became professor of the History of Philosophy and the Institute's first Fellow. He became, at the same time, through St. Michael's College, professor of Philosophy in the School of Graduate Studies of the University of Toronto. Two years later, 1946, he was elected president of the Pontifical Institute of Mediaeval Studies, succeeding Gerald Phelan, and was confirmed in office by the Sacred Congregation of Seminaries and Universities on 16 August of that year.

During his presidency, the Institute expanded its professoriate, adding new professors in history and theology, and strongly promoted the auxiliary disciplines, especially Latin and palaeography. It accelerated its publication policy, and it received its cherished *doctorum laudis* from
