

**A Review of *Essays on Philosophy and Economic Methodology* by Daniel M. Hausman, published by Cambridge University Press 1992, ISBN 0-521-41740-6.**

This book represents a collection seventeen essays written from 1980 to 1992 by an American philosopher of Economics.

The essays are prefaced by a brief introduction which summarises their themes. The introduction also tells how Hausman came to be involved in the philosophy of economics and how, with perfect timing, he entered the field in 1976 when the great wave of contemporary interest in the philosophy of economics was just beginning. In the ensuing years, the subject has become the province of a well-organised academic discipline.

The essays are divided into four sections. Part I, *Methodology and Appraisal*, comprises eight essays. These are concerned mainly with the issue of whether or not economics is a distinct science which requires a methodology different from that of the exact sciences. Attention is also focussed on the proposition, of Karl Popper and Milton Friedman, that the acceptability of an economic theory derives mainly, if not solely, from its predictive success. At least, the simplistic version of this proposition is rejected.

The essays of Part II, *Causality in Economics*, discuss the role of the concept of causality in economic theory. Hausman argues in favour of the notion of "causal realism"; and he is opposed to the idea that causality is only a relationship within the realm of conceptual objects.

Part III, *Cases and Puzzles*, represents a small collection oddments, each of which addresses a particular problem of economics and which together should serve to illustrate Hausman's general philosophical perspective.

Part IV, *Postscripts*, which is brief, contains two pieces which represent a manifesto for the philosophy of economics. Here the essential credo is that the philosophy of science is itself an empirical science which should aim to study what scientists actually do. This, it is declared, contrasts with the traditional approach which aimed to establish epistemological precepts.

Hausman is a post-modernist philosopher. That is to say, he eschews radical positivism in favour of a careful revisionism which amends the exaggerations and makes good the lacunas of the pristine doctrine. The consequence is that, whereas it is both balanced and moderate, his philosophy is particularly anodyne and it has no cutting edge. Even some metaphysics is allowed to creep into the philosophy under the disguise of common sense.

A good example of Hausman's tendencies is provided by his central essay on causal relations in economics. Here he insists that a distinction should be maintained between the mathematical structure of an equation system and the causal
