The mathematical turn in logic although given considerable torque by events of the nineteenth century can with assurance be dated from the final quarter of the seventeenth century in the impressively prescient work of Leibniz It is true that in the three hundred year run up to the Begriffsschrift one does not see a smoothly continuous evolution of the mathematical turn but the idea that logic is mathematics albeit perhaps only the most general part of mathematics is one that attracted some degree of support throughout the entire period in question Still as Alfred North Whitehead once noted the relationship between mathematics
