



September 1985 NATO sponsored an Advanced Study Workshop entitled Noise Induced Hearing Loss Basic and Applied Aspects. The meeting was held in a mountain retreat near Lucca Italy and was attended by scientists, clinicians and public officials from 12 countries. This was the third in a series of such conferences organized by the authors. The first two were supported by the United States National Institute of Occupational Safety and Health; their proceedings were published as *The Effects of Noise on Hearing* in 1976 and *New Perspectives on Noise Induced Hearing Loss* in 1982. The Organizing Committee approached NATO because it was felt that the problem of noise was common to all industrialized countries and was an especially serious problem for the military.
