results from a range of languages and theoretical frameworks Landau examines the far reaching repercussions of this simple claim Landau shows that all experiencer objects are grammaticalized as locative phrases introduced by a dative locative preposition Bare experiencer objects are in fact oblique too the preposition being null This preposition accounts for the oblique psych ological properties attested in case alternations cliticization resumption restrictions on passive formation and so on As locatives object experiencers may undergo locative inversion giving rise to the common phenomenon of quirky experiencers When covert this inversion endows object experiencers with wide scope attested in control binding and wh quantifier interactions Landau s synthesis thus provides a novel solution to some of the oldest puzzles in the generative study of psychological verbs The Locative Syntax of Experiencers offers the most comprehensive description of the syntax of psychological verbs to date documenting their special properties in more than twenty languages Its basic theoretical claim is readily translatable into alternative frameworks Existing accounts of psychological verbs either consider very few languages or fail to incorporate other theoretical frameworks this study takes a broader perspective informed by findings of four decades of research **Phrasal Movement and Its Kin** David Pesetsky, 2000-10-10 This study investigates the types of movement and movement like relations that link positions in syntactic structure David Pesetsky argues that there are three such relations Besides overt phasal movement there are two distinct types of movement without phonological effect covert phrasal movement and feature movement Focusing on wh guestions he shows how his classification of movement like relations allows us to understand the story behind wh questions in which an otherwise inviolable property of movement Attract Closest appears to be violated By demonstrating that more movement takes place in such configurations than previously suspected he shows that Attract Closest is actually not violated at all in these cases This conclusion draws on recent research in both syntax and semantics and depends crucially on Pesetsky's expanded repertoire of movement like relations Linguistic Inquiry Monograph No 37 **Linearization of Chains and Sideward Movement** Jairo Nunes, 2004-04-16 This highly original monograph treats movement operations within the Minimalist Program Jairo Nunes argues that traces are not grammatical primitives and that their properties follow from deeper features of the system and in particular that the phonetic realization of traces is determined by linearization computations coupled with economy conditions regarding deletion He proposes a version of the copy theory of movement according to which movement must be construed as a description of the interaction of the independent operations Copy Merge Form Chain and Chain Reduction Empirical evidence to support this claim includes instances of sideward movement between subtrees in a derivation According to this analysis the linearization of chains in the phonological component constrains sideward movement so that it is possible to account for standard properties of multiple gap constructions including parasitic gap and ATB constructions without construction specific operations or principles that are not independently motivated Theoretical linguists will find Linearization of Chains and Sideward Movement of great interest both theoretically and empirically The version of the copy

interrogatives and relative constructions and theoretical investigation of chain formation in grammar **Provocative Syntax** Phil Branigan, 2011 A new theory of syntactic movement within a Chomskyan framework Chomsky showed that no description of natural language syntax would be adequate without some notion of movement operations in a syntactic derivation It now seems likely that such movement transformations are formally simple operations in which a single phrase is displaced from its original position within a phrase marker but after more than fifty years of generative theorizing the mechanics of syntactic movement are still murky and controversial In Provocative Syntax Phil Branigan examines the forces that drive syntactic movement and offers a new synthetic model of the basic movement operation by reassembling in a novel way isolated ideas that have been suggested elsewhere in the literature.
