Following Huxley, Aragon, and Celine, he turned to prose. Drawing on his education in Greek and his love of theatre, he penned plays with insights so pertinent that they seem universally valid some six and a half decades later. Lajos Walder 1913-1945 was a well-known poet in 1930s Budapest, but his plays written in the early 1940s were not known until 1990 when they were first published in Hungarian and described by a major critic as uniquely beautiful creations of an original mind.
