De la pobreza al poder Duncan Green, 2008. Una de cada seis personas en el mundo lleva una vida marcada por la pobreza, hambre, enfermedades y preocupaciones por lo que el futuro les depara. Los ingresos de las 500 personas más ricas del mundo son mayores que los ingresos de las 416 millones de personas más pobres. Las comunidades pobres del planeta pagan el precio del cambio climático ocasionado principalmente por las proliferantes emisiones de carbono de los ricos. Semejantes extremos son a la vez moralmente repugnantes y un desperdicio de talento y potencial. Poner fin a la plaga de la pobreza extrema, la desigualdad y la amenaza del colapso medio ambiental es el gran desafío del siglo XXI.

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
