I am speaking of the philosophical concept of the category. In Aristotle's system, there were ten categories or predicaments of reality or being. These included substantiality, time, place, quantity, quality, and other aspects of knowable beings. The most notable thing about these categories is that they all have to do with what we would call objective realities. That is, none of them purport to describe subjective or mental states or conditions. In modern philosophy, i.e. philosophy since the time of Descartes, there was a swing of the pendulum in the opposite direction, from objectivity to subjectivity, culminating in the twelve new categories of Kant. All of Kant's categories were subjective ways of looking at reality. We can organize objective phenomena into universal unities; therefore, the first Kantian category is unity. We can separate objective phenomena into particular divisions; therefore, the second category is plurality. And so forth. With Hegel, the modern trend to subjectivism is arrested, and we have not surprisingly a new type of category: the category of the unity of thought and being of self and other, of subject and object.
