This originally appeared in Baehr and Dyer's edited collection Boxed-in: Women and Television in 1987. This book, alongside Pribram's 1988 collection Female Spectators: Looking at Film and Television, can be used as a benchmark against which to view the distance that feminist media criticism has advanced in the intervening years. Such comparisons demonstrate that pioneers in the field continue to mine the rich seam of materials available for the critic and to develop their work in new and challenging directions, many of which are signposted and extended in both readers by the work of younger writers coming for the first time to what both books clearly demonstrate constitutes itself properly as a field in its own right. That there is not more overlap is probably a reflection of the fact that certain well-known 'ancestral' pieces which have been heavily reproduced elsewhere have been omitted. This, however, can act to obscure the development of these brands of criticism for the neophyte reader. The cinematic ancestors of feminist television criticism remain a shadowy force. Hence Laura Mulvey is referenced ten times in the Brunsdon et al. collection and four times in Baehr and Gray. Given Mulvey's focus on film excluding her work itself is a reasonable strategy to adopt in books dealing largely with television but care must be taken if the reader is to serve as a starting point for students who are coming to the area for the very first time. Readers create canons and nothing can be assumed. All in all the Brunsdon et al. Reader is the more substantial. The extracts are longer, the critical background material is more extensive and each individual piece has a paragraph of introduction. Furthermore the reader as a whole has a useful bibliography, something which is absent in the Arnold collection. If a student were to have one of these books this reviewer would recommend the Oxford reader, but both provide a wonderful overview of a disciplinary area which will continue to grow and generate further important critical insights in our overall understanding of television and the media.
