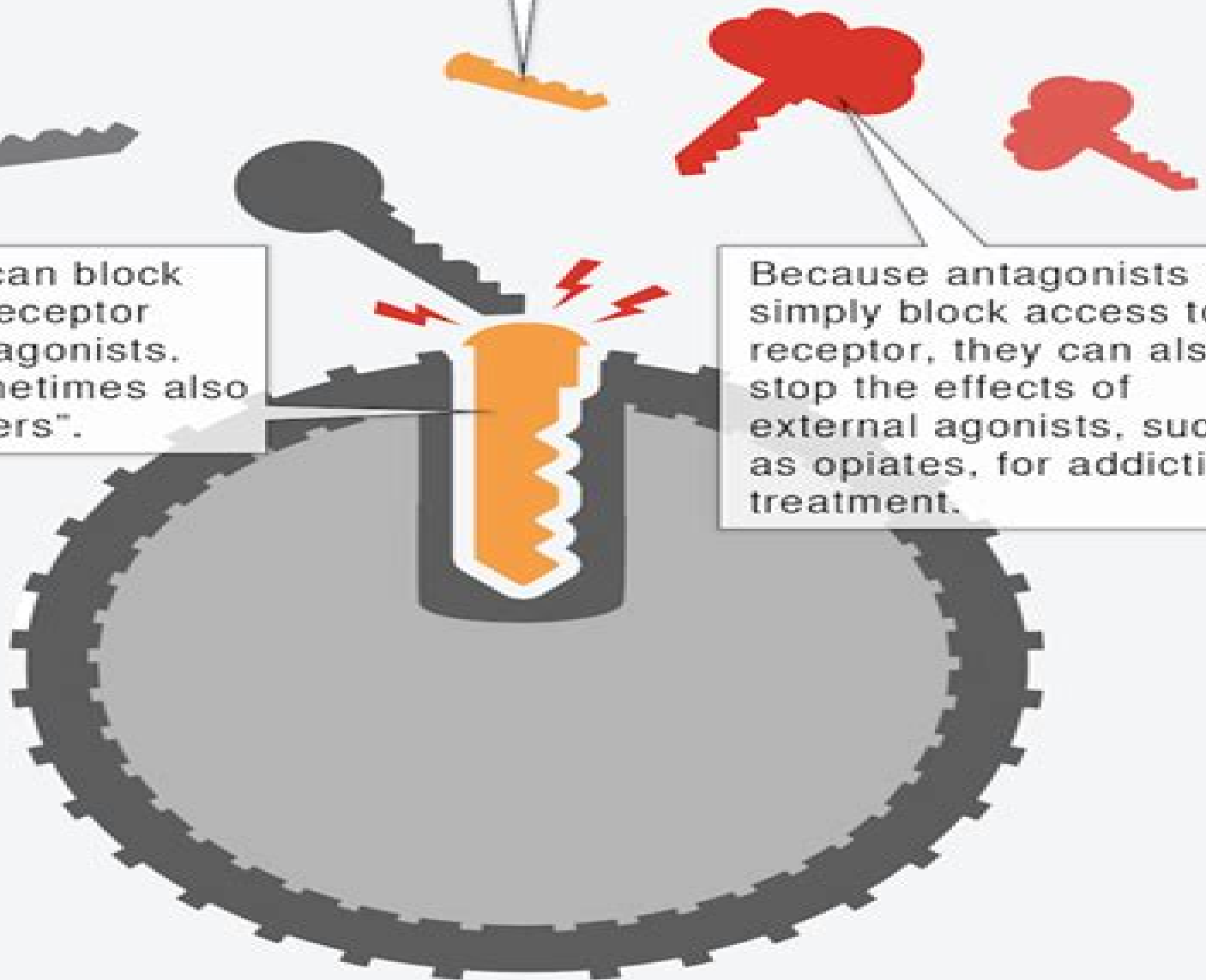


Antagonists work by binding to a cell's receptor and blocking access to the receptor from agonists in the body.
