### Language, Students with Learning Disabilities, and Students with Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder

Students with learning disabilities comprise a large, if somewhat poorly defined, segment of the population of children with special needs. This chapter describes both the specific language characteristics of children with learning disabilities and the effects of these language difficulties on their academic and social performance. In addition, the language and communication difficulties of students with attention deficit hyperactivity disorder are reviewed. Although these are considered separate disorders, both children with learning disabilities and those with attention deficit disorders often have language difficulties that impact their school success. Some suggestions are provided for teaching children with language-learning disabilities.

#### Keisha W.: A Case Study

Keisha W. is an 8-year-old African American student in a regular second-grade class. Her teacher is concerned about her lack of progress in reading and her poor socialization. The teacher also reports that Keisha is pleasant and cooperative but is very shy and reloctant to participate in groups. Keisha is reading at an early first-grade level, and her reading is slow and hesitant. Her first-grade teacher noticed similar problems with reading and socialization but hoped that the child would outgrow these problems.

Mrs. W. has struggled to provide for Keisha and her two brothers since her husband left her 3 years ago. Mrs. W. has held a succession of low-paying jobs and has been unemployed several times. The family lives in public housing in a high-crime neighborhood. Mrs. W. has reported that Keisha's early development was normal, although she remembers that Keisha had frequent colds and earaches and was always a quiet child.

Keisha was observed in the classroom during a group reading lesson and during group work on a writing assignment that followed the reading lesson. When called on to read, she read very quietly. She hesitated frequently and misread a number of words. She needed a great deal of (continued)
