Himnos Sumerios:

Himnos sumerios Federico Lara Peinado, 2006 Dentro de los géneros literarios sumerios los himnos ocuparon un lugar muy destacado debido no sólo a su tradición oral sino también a su hondo contenido religioso presente de modo inequívoco en tales composiciones religiosas. Prácticamente todos los dioses sumerios, los reyes más cualificados, los templos de mayor prestigio y los objetos de preciso contenido sagrado fueron glorificados mediante numerosos y adecuados himnos cuya rica tipología posibilitaba una gran variedad compositiva e interpretativa. Los himnos vinieron a ser una fórmula o solución para los oficiantes religiosos sumerios y quizá fieles en general, quienes en virtud del carácter religioso que la palabra y la música encerraban en sí mismas los repetían una y otra vez dentro del contexto ritual de una divinidad o entidad religiosa determinada. El himno sumerio no sólo se reduce a una larga enumeración de títulos laudatorios a modo de letanías estereotipadas sino que también descansaba íntimamente en supuestos pragmáticos buscándose con ellos en última instancia el favor de la divinidad.
