test of three principal documents in their original Spanish The first half of the book is devoted to an extensive history of the Caddos from De Soto's encounters in 1521 to the Caddos involvement in the Ghost Dance Religion of 1890 The second half discusses Caddo culture including origin legends and religious beliefs material culture social relations government warfare leisure and trade For this edition Helen Hornbeck Tanner also provides a new foreword surveying the scholarship published on the Caddos since Swanton's time
