Ricoeur's Personalist Republicanism Dries Deweer, 2017-08-14 Moral and political convictions never stand alone. They are always connected to an underlying view of mankind. Liberalism, which currently predominates, is connected to a focus on the free individual. Marxism thinks of man in terms of class struggle determined by economic relationships. Halfway the twentieth century a powerful alternative came about by the name of personalism. This term stood for a social and political thought based on the concept of the human person. This concept stresses that a human being only becomes human in relationship with others and in a commitment to values that go beyond one's individual interests. Although personalism has an important influence in western society in philosophical circles it is often regarded as dead and gone. This tension brings Paul Ricoeur to the fore as an interesting interlocutor because he was considered a representative of personalism in his younger years while he later on also supported fatal criticisms of original personalism. This book investigates to what extent the thought of Ricoeur bears a continuing stamp of personalism that allows him to instigate a personalist perspective within contemporary political philosophy. The final result lies on three fronts. First there is more clarity in the status of personalism in contemporary philosophy as Ricoeur's hermeneutical phenomenology shows that there are still viable means to elaborate the core ideas of personalism. Second a personalist kind of republicanism is shown to provide a valuable input in the contemporary philosophical debate on citizenship. Finally the most tangible result is a deeper understanding of the oeuvre of Ricoeur in the sense that this book shows that personalism is an important and above all underestimated perspective to understand his entire work.

Ricoeur at the Limits of Philosophy Barnabas Aspray, 2022-08-25 Can finite humans grasp universal truth? Is it possible to think beyond the limits of reason? The Rhetoricity of Philosophy Blake D. Scott, 2024-08-02 This book aims to recast the way that philosophers understand rhetoric. Rather than follow most philosophers in conceiving rhetoric as a specific way of speaking or writing it shows that rhetoric is better understood as a dimension of all human discourse and action, what the author calls rhetoricity. This book provides the first philosophical treatment of rhetoricity. It is motivated by two ongoing developments. The first is the debate between Alain Badiou and Barbara Cassin about philosophy's relation to rhetoric. Both Badiou and Cassin are critical of rhetoric albeit for different reasons. Second there has been a growing resurgence of interest in rhetoric considering the recent rise in authoritarian politics as well as new forms of propaganda driven by persuasive technologies.

This book identifies the common target of Badiou's and Cassin's otherwise incompatible critiques rhetoric's conception of audience. It offers a fresh take on the new rhetoric project of Chaim Perelman and Lucie Olbrechts-Tyteca putting their work into conversation with the Badiou-Cassin debate. The book then turns to the hermeneutic philosophy of Paul Ricoeur in search of an expanded conception of audience. It shows that Ricoeur's hermeneutic philosophy allows us to extend Perelman and Olbrechts-Tyteca's psychological notion of audience to texts themselves and to argue that human beings have a rhetorical capacity to reflect on audiences in search of what is potentially persuasive. *The Rhetoricity of Philosophy* will be of interest to scholars and advanced students working in contemporary European philosophy, rhetoric, argumentation studies, and social theory.
