German Idealism's Trinitarian Legacy Dale M. Schlitt, 2016-10-20 A study of the roots and legacy of German Idealist philosophy for trinitarian theology. Dale M. Schlitt presents a study of trinitarian thought as it was understood and debated by the German Idealists, broadly engaging Schelling's philosophical interpretations of Trinity as well as Hegel's and analyzing how these Idealist interpretations influenced later philosophers and theologians. Deification and Modern Orthodox Theology Petre Maican, 2023-04-24 Modern Orthodox identity is deeply interwoven with the notion of deification or union with God. For some theologians, deification represents the lens through which most, if not all, theological questions should be engaged. In this volume, Petre Maican undertakes the task of critically examining the extent to which deification informs the main debates inside Orthodox theology, focusing on four essential loci: anthropology, the Trinity, epistemology, and ecclesiology. Maican argues that while deification remains central to anthropology and the Orthodox understanding of the Trinity, it seems less relevant in the areas of ecclesiology and complexifies the Orthodox approach to Scripture and Tradition.

Being the Church Edward Rommen, 2017-07-18 If the divine liturgy really is as beautiful as we claim, wouldn't more people attend?

Wouldn't the church grow? Driven by our desire for growth we count, we analyze, we make charts and we strategize but often with few discernible results. That is probably the result of focusing on secondary aspects of church life. As we know, the very existence of a church is a gift of God's presence and not the result of any particular actions taken by human beings. For that reason, church is primarily about being something rather than doing or achieving something. So the growth of the church is not reflected in ever increasing numbers, dollars, and activities but rather in steadily growing conformity to the divine ideal. So in order to evaluate ecclesial growth we will first have to ask what the church is supposed to be. One answer to that question is captured in the four marks of the church given in the creed: Oneness, Holiness, Catholicity, and Apostolicity. These four characteristics serve as a matrix or framework within which we can focus on the primary aspects of ecclesial being and help it grow and become what it was intended to be.

The Crisis of Western Philosophy Vladimir Sergeyevich Solovyov, 1996

This book is the seminal work in which Solovyov developed his religious philosophy. In it he undertakes a stunning critique of positivism by which he understands the entire philosophy of Western rationalism which he sees as setting up a conflict between reason and faith and reason and nature. In the modern period he finds abundant evidence for reason's war against nature in Western philosophy from Descartes to Hegel. Positivism, the leading philosophy in his time, Solovyov also finds repugnant. In its place he proposes his great theme of total unity which was to become the dominant theme in Russian philosophy. This is the work that launched Russian religious philosophy and is a must for anyone interested in the subject.

The Holy Grail and the Eucharist Sergiĭ Bulgakov, Sergei Nikolaevich Bulgakov, 1997

These two moving studies by the eminent Orthodox theologian and sophiologist Father Sergei Bulgakov are remarkable in many ways. The first is a unique consideration from the point of view of Eastern Christianity of the Holy Grail, the chalice used by Joseph of Arimathea to catch the blood and water as it flowed from Jesus' side when it was pierced on the Cross by the spear of Longinus. This moment is described in John 19:34. Bulgakov's essay is a dogmatic exegesis of this passage in which, with astounding passion and precision, he reveals that the Earth itself and hence the human universe is the Grail wherein Christ lives forever. The second essay is also unique, the most important contribution to eucharistic theology by an Orthodox theologian. In the West, the meaning of the Communion bread and wine as the Christ's Body and Blood has been interpreted largely in philosophical terms deriving from Aristotle and Thomas Aquinas. Bulgakov insists on a christological and Gospel-based interpretation, one with tremendous significance for our understanding of the supernatural and sophianic nature of a world interpenetrated by the divine. This little book is a priceless gift enriching our understanding of the Christian mystery and two of its deepest aspects: the Grail and the Eucharist.
