El franquismo se fue de fiesta Claudio Hernández Burgos, César Rina Simón, 2022-06-27. La dictadura franquista además de consolidarse mediante un régimen de terror lo hizo apoyándose en múltiples ritos festivos creados ex novo o imaginados como tradicionales por parte de unas comunidades que renovaban con ellos sus vínculos y memorias sociales. Este libro aborda desde una amplia perspectiva cronológica y geográfica y con un enfoque histórico y cultural la política relación de la dictadura franquista con las fiestas populares como referentes políticos sociales y culturales fundamentales para comprender el siglo XX. De esta forma se abarca un amplio abanico de formas y expresiones que van desde las estrategias del régimen para convertir los entornos festivos en espacios de afirmación nacionalcatólica o fascistización a los comportamientos heterodoxos o contestatarios tolerados en el marco del ritual. Se analizan en profundidad fenómenos festivos como Las Fallas, los Sanfermines, la Semana Santa en Andalucía, las fiestas mayores de Cataluña, la romería de El Rocío o el folclore de la Sección Femenina, el Día de Asturias, las fiestas rurales en Mallorca o los Carnavales de Cádiz. El análisis de estas festividades y de su evolución mediante enfoques que priorizan una mirada desde abajo permite replantear cuestiones esenciales en torno a la legitimación en el espacio público y las expresiones culturales de la dictadura franquista.

de manifestaciones que se relacionaban con la naturaleza con sus creencias cosmogónicas y religiosas y con elementos de la vida como colectivo aspectos que les implicaba definir tiempos espacios y lugares para su escenificación Considerados estos ceremoniales como ejes de sostenibilidad de una comunidad cultural y política proseguimos el análisis tomando como campo el choque con referentes diferentes impuestos por la presencia española a partir de la década de 1530 Se analizan las implicaciones surgidas del cruce de estos dos mundos y nos adentramos en la descripción e interpretación de las denominadas fiestas religiosas del cristianismo y las estatales de la monarquía española escenificadas en el territorio de lo que hoy se denomina Bogotá El estudio analiza las variaciones o permanencias que se presentan con el advenimiento de la independencia neogranadina en el siglo XIX poca en la cual Bogotá se convierte en uno de los lugares donde se escenifica una nueva tipología de fastos que celebra diversos referentes de tal manera que la ciudad sirve de plataforma para la puesta en escena de fiestas de las constituciones patrióticas nacionales julias cívicas republicanas y de resacralización del hispanismo Es una poca de disputas entre la modernidad la modernización y la tradición conceptos estos que serán puestos en escena en las manifestaciones festivas De igual manera se estudian las festividades de celebración de las victorias militares a finales del siglo XIX en que sobresalen las ceremonias de triunfo en las guerras internas así como los festejos en Bogotá del Centenario de la Independencia en 1910 culminando el análisis con una interpretación sobre la historia del Himno Nacional como emblema de nación moderna visto en el marco de las complejidades políticas y sociales que se vivían en la poca de su promulgación oficial en 1920

Building Yanhuitlan Alessia Frassani, 2017-10-12 Through years of fieldwork in the state of Oaxaca Mexico art historian and archaeologist Alessia Frassani formulated a compelling question How did Mesoamerican society maintain its distinctive cultural heritage despite colonization by the Spanish In Building Yanhuitlan she focuses on an imposing structure a sixteenth century Dominican monastery complex in the village of Yanhuitlan For centuries the buildings have served a central role in the village landscape and the lives of its people Ostensibly there is nothing indigenous about the complex or the artwork inside So how does such a place fit within the Mixteca where Frassani acknowledges a continuity of indigenous culture in the towns plazas markets churches and rural surroundings To understand the monastery complex and

Mesoamerican cultural heritage in the wake of conquest Frassani calls for a shifting definition of indigenous identity one that acknowledges the ways indigenous peoples actively took part in the development of post conquest Mesoamerican culture Frassani relates the history of Yanhuitlan by examining the rich store of art and architecture in the town s church and convent bolstering her account with more than 100 color and black and white illustrations She presents the first two centuries of the church complex s construction works maintenance and decorations as the product of cultural political and economic negotiation between Mixtec caciques Spanish encomenderos and Dominican friars The author then ties the village s present day religious celebrations to the colonial past and traces the cult of specific images through these celebrations history Cultural artifacts Frassani demonstrates do not need pre Hispanic origins to be considered genuinely Mesoamerican the processes attached to their appropriation are more meaningful than their having any pre Hispanic past Based on original and unpublished documents and punctuated with stunning photography Building Yanhuitlan combines archival and ethnographic work with visual analysis to make an innovative statement regarding artistic forms and to tell the story of a remarkable community
