[With Plates, Including Portraits.] Joseph Howard PARKS, 1962 General Leonidas Polk, C.S.A., the Fighting Bishop Joseph Howard Parks, 1992 This is the first full length life of General Leonidas Polk Bishop militant of the Confederacy since the biography published by his son more than a half century ago It is the story of a man whose deeds of peace were no less than his feats of war The first Episcopal bishop of Louisiana and the Southwest and founder of the University of the South Sewanee Polk climaxed his career as one of the foremost figures of the Confederacy Polk was born in Raleigh North Carolina in 1806 He attended West Point where he became a friend of Jefferson Davis Turning from the military to the ministry after graduation Polk won the praise of the Episcopal Church for his abilities in directing and organizing and was eventually commissioned missionary bishop of the Southwest However so great was his belief in the cause of the South that each state was independent and could secede if it chose that with the approach of the Civil War he announced the secession his diocese left the embryo university he was building his Louisiana bishopric and episcopacy and buckled the sword over the gown He accepted appointment as major general in the Provisional Army of the Confederacy in late June 1861 and was assigned to command Department No 2 with headquarters at Memphis He soon led his forces into Kentucky and occupied Columbus When Generals A S Johnston and P G T Beauregard were assigned to the West Polk became subordinate to them He commanded a corps at Shiloh a wing in the Kentucky campaign a corps at Stone s River and a wing at Chickamauga Disagreement with General Bragg after Chickamauga resulted in Polk s relief from command in the Army of the Tennessee and his transfer to Mississippi When J E Johnston succeeded Bragg in North Georgia Polk s force was ordered to his assistance The Bishop General was killed at Pine Mountain on June 14 1864 Jacket The Church at War: The Military Activities of Bishops, Abbots and Other Clergy in England, c. 900-1200 Daniel Gerrard, 2016-10-04 The fighting bishop or abbot is a familiar figure to medievalists and much of what is known of the military organization of England in this period is based on ecclesiastical evidence Unfortunately the fighting cleric has generally been regarded as merely a baron in clerical dress and has consequently fallen into the gap between military and ecclesiastical history This study addresses three main areas which clergy engaged in military activity in England why and when By what means did they do so And how did others understand and react to these activities The book shows that however vivid such characters as Odo of Bayeux might be in the historical imagination there was no archetypal militant prelate There was enormous variation in the character of the clergy that became involved in warfare their circumstances the means by which they pursued their military objectives and the way in which they were treated by contemporaries and described by chroniclers An appreciation of the individual fighting cleric must be both thematically broad and keenly aware of his context Such individuals cannot therefore be simply slotted into easy categories even or perhaps especially when those categories are informed by contemporary polemic The implications of

this study for our understanding of clerical identity are considerable as the easy distinction between clerics acting in a secular or ecclesiastical capacity almost entirely breaks down and the legal structures of the period are shown to be almost as equivocal and idiosyncratic as the literary depictions The implications for military history are equally striking as organisational structures are shown to be more temporary fluid and political than had previously been understood

While slavery and secession divided the Union during the American Civil War, they also severed the Northern and Southern dioceses of the Protestant Episcopal Church. In *Challenges on the Emmaus Road*, T. Felder Dorn focuses on the way Northern and Southern Episcopal bishops confronted and responded to the issues and events of their turbulent times. Prior to the Civil War, Southern bishops were industrious in evangelizing among enslaved African Americans, but at the same time they supported the legal and social aspects of the peculiar institution. Southern and Northern bishops parted company over the institution of slavery, not over the place of blacks in the Episcopal Church. As Southern states left the Union, Southern dioceses separated from the Episcopal Church in the United States. The book's title was inspired by the Gospel of Luke 24:13-35, in which the resurrected Jesus Christ walked unrecognized with his disciples and discussed the events of his own crucifixion and disappearance from his tomb. Dorn perceives that scriptural episode as a metaphor for the responses of Episcopal bishops to the events of the Civil War era. Dorn carefully summarizes the debates within the church and in secular society surrounding the important topics of the era. In doing so, he lays the groundwork for his own interpretations of church history and also provides authentic data for other church scholars to investigate such topics as faith and doctrine, evangelism, and the administrative history of one of the most important institutions in America. Dorn devotes the final chapters to the postwar reunification of the Episcopal Church and Southern bishops' involvement in establishing the Commission on Freedmen to offer help with the educational and spiritual needs of the recently emancipated slaves.
