The first appearance in book form was published by William Heinemann of London in 1898 It is the first person narrative of the adventures of an unnamed protagonist and his brother in Surrey and London as Earth is invaded by Martians Written between 1895 and 1897 it is one of the earliest stories that detail a conflict between mankind and an extraterrestrial race The novel is one of the most commented on works in the science fiction canon The War of the Worlds has two parts Book One The Coming of the Martians and Book Two The Earth under the Martians The narrator a philosophically inclined author struggles to return to his wife while seeing the Martians lay waste to southern England Book One also imparts the experience of his brother also unnamed who describes events in the capital and escapes the Martians by boarding a ship near Tillingham on the Essex coast The plot has been related to invasion literature of the time.
