insight Whoever goes his own road as I do must needs allow many a misunderstanding about himself to pass That however he can put up with easily enough For such misunderstandings are in the main inevitable in his eyes when he recalls the mental type of those who misjudge him I look back not without humorous feelings upon many a critical judgment that I have suffered in the course of my literary career At the outset matters went fairly well I wrote about Goethe and his philosophy What I said there appeared to many to be of such a nature that they could file it in their mental pigeon holes.
