Early Christians sensing the lack in Paul's formula created an alternative typology between Eve the mother of all the living and Mary the mother of Jesus. Eventually early theologians attempted to solve the soteriological problem Eve posed by coordinating these two typologies. This solution however produced a further dilemma. Either Mary had to be posited as a second savior or the salvation offered to Eve in the revised scheme had to be second class. Neither option is theologically acceptable. *The Disappearance of Eve and the Gender of Christ* proposes a solution to this problem. It revises Paul's original

formula and with it a set of common claims about Christ's sex and gender. It accepts Christ as the new Adam and the new Eve and accepts that Christ is theologically speaking trans. Carnahan offers a new theology of sex and gender as a calling within a context of responsibility as a framework for making sense of Eve, Christ and ourselves.
