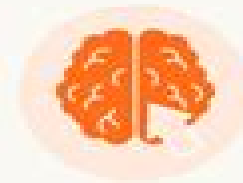
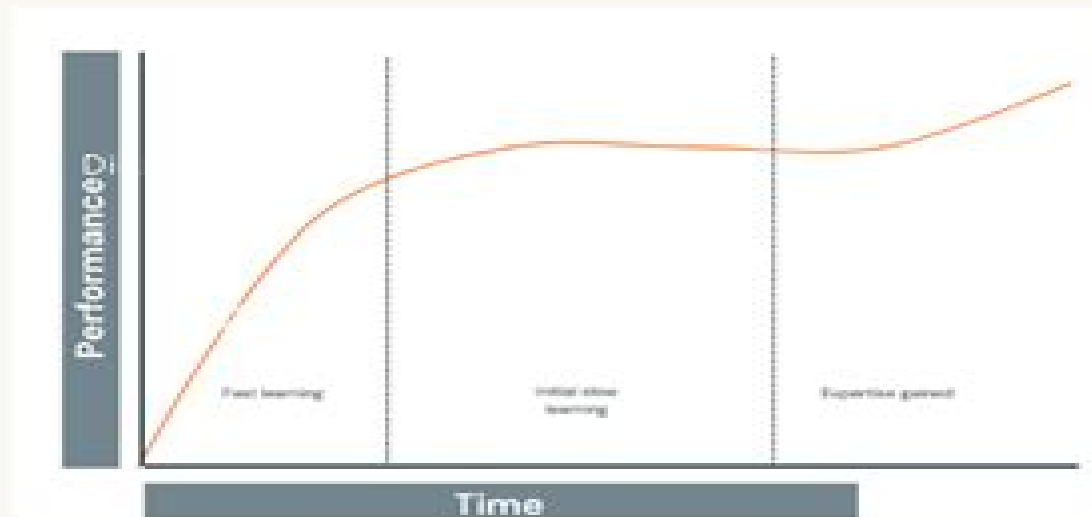




The Learning Curve

$$Y = aX^b$$

- Y = average time over the measured duration
- a = time spent to complete the task the first time
- X = total amount of attempts completed
- b = slope of the function
