Cancer Definition

- Group of more than 200 diseases
- Characterized by uncontrolled and unregulated growth of cells
- Abnormal cell proliferation
 - One bad cell makes more bad cells
 - o "The moldy blueberry"
 - Cancer cells do not die
- Lack of controlled growth and cell division
- Involves any tissue of the body
- Evades natural cell death (apoptosis)
- Ability to spread (metastasis)

Pathophysiology

- Progression/recurrence
 - Characterized by
 - Increased growth rate of tumor
 - Invasiveness
 - Metastasis
 - Most frequent sites of metastasis are lungs, brain, bone, liver, and adrenal glands
 - We always biopsy nearby lymph nodes for metastasis
