Strachan, Alison O'Malley-Younger, 2010 The essays in this collection all revolve around the notion of change in Ireland whether by revolution or by evolution Developments in the shared histories of Ireland and Great Britain are an important theme throughout the book The volume begins by examining

two remarkable Irishmen on the make in Georgian London the boxing historian Pierce Egan and the extraordinary Charles Macklin eighteenth century actor playwright and manslaughterer The focus then moves to aspects of Hibernian influence and the presence of the Irish Diaspora in Great Britain from the medieval period up to the late nineteenth and early twentieth century celebrations of St Patrick's Day in Manchester The book also considers the very different attitudes to the British Empire evident in the career of the 1916 rebel Sir Roger Casement and the Victorian philologist and colonial servant Whitley Stokes Further essays look at writings by Scottish Marxists on the state of Ireland in the 1920s and the pronouncements on the Troubles by John Lennon and Paul McCartney The book also examines change in the culture of the island of Ireland from the development of the Irish historical novel in the nineteenth century to ecology in contemporary Irish women s poetry to the present state of the Roman Catholic Church in Ireland Contemporary Irish authors examined include Roddy Doyle Joseph O Connor and Martin McDonagh Our Secret Discipline Helen Vendler, 2007-11-29 The fundamental difference between rhetoric and poetry according to Yeats is that rhetoric is the expression of ones quarrels with others while poetry is the expression of ones guarrel with oneself Through exquisite attention to outer and inner forms Vendler explores the most Metamorphosis David Gallagher, 2009 The origins of selected instances of inventive reaches of the poets mind metamorphosis in Germanic literature are traced from their roots in Ovid's Metamorphoses grouped roughly on an ascending evolutionary scale invertebrates birds animals and mermaids Whilst a broad range of mythological legendary fairytale and folktale traditions have played an appreciable part Ovid s Metamorphoses is still an important comparative analysis and reference point for nineteenth and twentieth century German language narratives of transformations Metamorphosis is most often used as an index of crisis an existential crisis of the subject or a crisis in a society s moral social or cultural values Specifically selected texts for analysis include Jeremias Gotthelf's Die schwarze Spinne 1842 with the terrifying metamorphoses of Christine into a black spider the metamorphosis of Gregor Samsa in Kafka s Die Verwandlung 1915 ambiguous metamorphoses in ETA Hoffmann's Der goldne Topf 1814 Hermann Hesse's Piktors Verwandlungen 1925 Der Steppenwolf 1927 and Christoph Ransmayr's Die letzte Welt 1988 Other mythical metamorphoses are examined in texts by Bachmann Fougu Fontane Goethe Nietzsche Nelly Sachs Thomas Mann and Wagner and these and many others confirm that metamorphosis is used historically scientifically for religious purposes to highlight identity sexuality a dream state or for metaphoric metonymic or allegorical reasons Builders of My Soul Brian Arkins, 1990-01-01 To Yeats as well as to Eliot Pound Joyce and other major writers as Erich Auerbach put it in Mimesis Antiquity means liberation and a broadening of horizons not in any sense a new limitation or servitude That is why Greco Roman themes can be endlessly stimulating why Yeats could call the Greek and Roman writers the builders of my soul Brian Arkin's thematic consideration of Yeat's subject matter under philosophy myth religion history literature visual art and Byzantium allows us to see coherently how Yeats exploited this material and how especially in his middle and later periods he transformed and metamorphosed subject matter
