A Dictionary of High Frequency Function Words in Literary Chinese is the first comprehensive work on the subject that constitutes a new approach to teaching and learning by providing both a reference tool and a reader. This dictionary can serve both as a reference book and as an anthology for teaching and learning literary Chinese: the premodern written language and both ancient and contemporary Chinese culture. All Chinese words are provided with Putonghua romanization to facilitate learning and recall; through sound, special pronunciations are explained.
