The topics and problems I focus on are those that have arisen most often and most insistently when I have thought the poem in translation and in the original as I have done every year since 1968 This book is a literary study of the Iliad I have not discussed historical archaeologoical or even linguistic questions except where they are directly relevant to literary interpretation Throughout I have emphasized what is
