of fixed well ordered preferences and perfect information makes the theory inadequate for situations of change and uncertainty aggregation as methodological individualists rational choice theorists can only view structure and culture as aggregates and cannot incorporate structural or cultural influences as emergent properties which have an effect upon decision making The critique is grounded in discussion of a wide range of social issues including race marriage health and education
