Snook, 2011-09-19 On April 14 1994 two U S Air Force F 15 did the AWACS crew fail to intervene fighters accidentally shot down two U S Army Black Hawk Helicopters over Northern Iraq killing all twenty six peacekeepers onboard In response to this disaster the complete array of military and civilian investigative and judicial procedures ran their course After almost two years of investigation with virtually unlimited resources no culprit emerged no bad guy showed himself no smoking gun was found This book attempts to make sense of this tragedy a tragedy that on its surface makes no sense at all With almost twenty years in uniform and a Ph D in organizational behavior Lieutenant Colonel Snook writes from a unique perspective A victim of friendly fire himself he develops individual group organizational and cross level accounts of the accident and applies a rigorous analysis based on behavioral science theory to account for critical links in the causal chain of events By explaining separate pieces of the puzzle and analyzing each at a different level the author removes much of the mystery surrounding the shootdown Based on a grounded theory analysis Snook offers a dynamic cross level mechanism he calls practical drift the slow steady uncoupling of practice from written procedure to complete his explanation His conclusion is disturbing This accident happened because or perhaps in spite of everyone behaving just the way we would expect them to behave just the way theory would predict The shootdown was a normal accident in a highly reliable *Drift into Failure* Sidney Dekker, 2016-12-05 What does the collapse of sub prime lending have in common organization with a broken jackscrew in an airliner's tailplane Or the oil spill disaster in the Gulf of Mexico with the burn up of Space Shuttle Columbia These were systems that drifted into failure While pursuing success in a dynamic complex environment with limited resources and multiple goal conflicts a succession of small everyday decisions eventually produced breakdowns on a massive scale We have trouble grasping the complexity and normality that gives rise to such large events We hunt for broken parts fixable properties people we can hold accountable Our analyses of complex system breakdowns remain depressingly linear depressingly componential imprisoned in the space of ideas once defined by Newton and Descartes The growth of complexity in society has outpaced our understanding of how complex systems work and fail Our technologies have gotten ahead of our theories We are able to build things deep sea oil rigs jackscrews collateralized debt obligations whose properties we understand in isolation But in competitive regulated societies their connections proliferate their interactions and interdependencies multiply their complexities mushroom This book explores complexity theory and systems thinking to understand better how complex systems drift into failure It studies sensitive dependence on initial conditions unruly technology tipping points diversity and finds that failure emerges opportunistically non randomly from the very webs of relationships that breed success and that are supposed to protect organizations from disaster It develops a vocabulary that
