

Labor Council their rebel girl she championed the rights of workers and organized women to fight for themselves In the 1930s as a member of the feisty new political movement the Co operative Commonwealth Federation she joined in the struggles of the unemployed for work and wages Then in 1937 as the first woman ever elected to Vancouver City Council she led the fight for low income housing As was typical for women of her class and time Helena did not keep personal records nor did organizational records exist to any extent Irene Howard made it her task over a period of years to search out and assemble details of Helena s life and career and to interview old comrades who knew Helena and the turbulent times in which she lived Herself a miner's daughter the author brings to her subject an affectionate regard and sympathy qualified by the larger view of the scholar and researcher The result is a lively biography shot through with humour and pathos that pays homage to Helena Gutteridge and to many of the people who have been inspired by a cause and who have taught us about Literary History of Canada Carl F.
