These authors' modernist formal experimentation was provoked by the immediate individualistic pleasures and thrills of mass culture. In competition with new media experiences such as movies and recorded music, they simultaneously rejected and embraced modernity. Situated at the crossing points of literary criticism, philosophy, media studies, and history, *Virtual Modernism* provides an examination of Progressive Era preoccupations with the cognitive and corporeal effects of new media technologies that traces an important genealogy of present-day concerns with virtuality.
