edition and existing as it does only in the large quarto form given to those illustrations it cannot make any claim to be a handy volume edition Mr Wright s translation however still holds its place as the best English version and the present reprint besides having undergone careful revision embodies the corrections but not the expurgations of the sixth edition which differed from those preceding it The notes too have for the most part been added by the reviser
