The principal tools in that response were the strike aircraft which took the offensive to the aggressor Although from 2010 to 2020 fixed wing carrier aviation was not part of the Fleet Air Arm with the advent of the navy s two new aircraft carriers HMS Queen Elizabeth and HMS Prince of Wales that capability has been restored.
