Settling Babies Into Childcare Settings

Bables can find starting a childcare setting extremely everwhelming. It is important to remember that for habies everything feels different to them and for many it will be the first time they have been separated from their key caregivers. As educators, our rale is to settle bables quickly providing warmth and care to ensure positive outcomes for their wellbeing.

If this is achieved, bables will learn that educators know them, will help them and comfort them in the absence of their primary caregiver.

Strategies for Setting Rabins

Use the key person approach consistently to help babies form a close relationship with one (or two key people) in the setting. These educators will need to be highly responsive to liables' needs, supporting care routines as well as offering comfort and tuning into physical and emotional cose.

Communicate regularly and build relationships with the bally's family, offering them reassurance as the bully settles. Use facial expressions, gestures and body language, such as smiling, nodding, giving eye-contact and making similar sounds to those babies are vocalising, this is useful to mirror and emosthius with their emotions.
