World War II Allied **Encirclement Of The German Armies.** Major Braden DeLauder, 2014-08-15 By Aug 1944 the Allies had broken out of the Normandy beachhead and were rapidly exploiting a breakthrough in the German lines In early Aug Hitler ordered a heavy single pronged attack to the west toward Avranches to cut off the US forces to the south With the Ultra intelligence Bradley recognized this as an opportunity to encircle the German Army in France By turning Patton's Third Army in the south north towards Argentan Bradley formed the lower jaw of a pincer movement while Montgomery ordered Crerar's First Canadian Army south to push towards Falaise to form the upper jaw Connecting the Allied armies between Falaise and Argentan would completely surround the German army The encirclement of the German forces would be known as the Falaise pocket To the
