# **Idiosyncratic Toxicity**

- Idiosyncratic drug reactions are <u>unpredictable</u> and appear in a <u>very small</u> number of patients (<1: 10,000 patients)</li>
- Due to their infrequent nature these effects are not typically observed in clinical trials or pre-clinical animal studies
- The risk of developing an idiosyncratic adverse effect is <u>not related</u> to either the drug's <u>dose</u> or <u>mechanism of action</u>
- There appears to be a strong genetic component for susceptibility to these types of adverse effects
- Idiosyncratic adverse effects can be severe and are the most common reason for drug withdrawals
- The most frequent organs affected include the liver, skin and blood cells
  - Hepatoxicity, Skin rash, Stevens Johnson Syndrome, Thrombocytopenia & Anemia
