

Idiosyncratic Toxicity

- Idiosyncratic drug reactions are unpredictable and appear in a very small number of patients (<1: 10,000 patients)
- Due to their infrequent nature these effects are not typically observed in clinical trials or pre-clinical animal studies
- The risk of developing an idiosyncratic adverse effect is not related to either the drug's dose or mechanism of action
- There appears to be a strong genetic component for susceptibility to these types of adverse effects
- Idiosyncratic adverse effects can be severe and are the most common reason for drug withdrawals
- The most frequent organs affected include the liver, skin and blood cells
 - Hepatotoxicity, Skin rash, Stevens Johnson Syndrome, Thrombocytopenia & Anemia
