Hitler's Commander Steven H. Newton, 2006-01-03 Field Marshal Walther Model 1891 1945 was an extremely capable and aggressive German commander who rose through the ranks of the Wehrmacht's high command during World War II. His expertise in rebuilding broken fronts earned him the nickname of the Fuhrer's Fireman and throughout the war Hitler relied on the rapidly promoted general to save his army in several desperate situations despite the fact that Model was often quite blunt with his erratic Fuhrer. Model's greatest achievement was the restoration of stability along the eastern front in June 1944. In August he was sent to restore the deteriorating western front where he re-established a strong defensive line along the West Wall. In September he was second in command at the Battle of the Bulge and was leading the German army when it collapsed at the end of the war. Rather than surrender he shot himself in April 1945. Although Model destroyed most of his personal papers just before he died, Stephen H. Newton draws on a wide variety of original German sources including extensive Wehrmacht archival material to tell the first and only authoritative story of the commander who was Hitler's favorite.

Hitler's Heroes During Operation Barbarossa Jeremy Dixon, 2024-11-30 Profiles the 178 generals awarded the Knight's Cross during the early months of Hitler's invasion of the Soviet Union. This is a study of the officers who were promoted to the rank of general and who were also awarded the Knight's Cross during the early period of Hitler's assault upon the Soviet Union. This takes us from the great onslaught of Operation Barbarossa through to Hitler's decision to abandon his attempt to capture Moscow and adopt a temporary defensive stance due to the early onset of winter. Such was the scale of operations during these momentous first six months of the war on the Eastern Front there were endless opportunities for officers to display courage and leadership. This resulted in a total of 172 generals: twenty-five Generalmajors, fifty-five Generalleutnants, eighty-three full Generals, eight Generalobersts and one Generalfeldmarschall being awarded the Knight's Cross in this period alone. One such recipient was General der Artillerie Erich Marcks who personally directed the fire of his guns against enemy bunkers at very close range. On the day he was notified of his award of the Knight's Cross he was seriously wounded and had to have his left leg amputated. Despite this he returned to service in March 1942 and was later awarded the Knight's Cross with Oakleaves.

General der Infanterie Ernst Schroth, the Commanding General of the XII Army Corps, was awarded the Knight's Cross for his part in the attack on the Brest Litvosk Fortress in June 1941. Considered a staunch supporter of Hitler, he was appointed to the Court of Honor which investigated those members of the Wehrmacht who had participated in the 20 July 1944 Valkyrie plot to kill the Fuhrer.

Hermann Heinrich Behrend was just a Major when he was awarded the Knight's Cross on 15 July 1941. This was for his actions while commanding I Battalion of the 489th Infantry Regiment in its successful breakthrough of the enemy's heavily defended lines southeast and east of Tauragė in Lithuania on 22 June 1941. Behrend continued to display

great courage and resourcefulness which saw him rise to the rank of Generalmajor and the later awards of both the Knight's Cross with Oakleaves and the Knight's Cross with Oakleaves and Swords. With each of these 178 entries there is a detailed description of how and where the Knight's Cross was won and in the case of the higher awards such as the Oakleaves Swords and Diamonds who presented the award where and when. This study provides details of their rank and command at the time of the award as well as also detailing their career during the war and after with investigations into their fate and post war life. of the fighting in Russia between Hitler's assault upon the Soviet Union Operation Barbarossa and the complete destruction of the German 6th Army at Stalingrad. The Germans lost 500 000 soldiers during the Stalingrad campaign, some 91 000 of whom were taken prisoner, a number which included 2 000 officers, twenty three generals and one Generalfeldmarschall Friedrich Paulus. There were 149 officers who later held the rank of general who were awarded the Knight's Cross for their actions on the Eastern Front between 6 December 1941 and 2 February 1943. One such recipient was Maximilian Fretter Pico who as Generalmajor and Commander of the 97th Infantry Division was awarded the Knight's Cross on 26 December 1941. He was later promoted to Generalleutnant and in June 1942 was Commander of the Army Detachment Fretter Pico with the rank of General der Artillerie. He was awarded the Knight's Cross with Oakleaves as Commanding General of the XXX Army Corps for actions in the Don and Donez area on 16 January 1944. He was personally presented with the award at the Obersalzberg by Hitler. Dietrich von Saucken was awarded the Knight's Cross with Oakleaves and Swords for his bravery and leadership whilst commanding the 4th Panzer Division on the Russian Front. On 8 May 1945 he was awarded the Knight's Cross with Oakleaves, Swords and Diamonds as General der Panzertruppe and Commander in Chief of Army Headquarters East Prussia and presented by Hitler's successor Grossadmiral Karl Dönitz. Saucken was later captured by the Soviets who flew him to Moscow for interrogation and he was later sentenced to twenty five years imprisonment. The youngest general in the German Army to be awarded the Knight's Cross with Oakleaves and Swords on 23 January 1944 was Erich Brenfänger who was only 29 years old at the time. His award was presented personally by Hitler at his headquarters the Wolf's Lair in Rastenburg. At the time he held the rank of Major and was promoted to Oberstleutnant in February 1944 and was promoted to Generalmajor on 28 April 1945 and named as Battle Commandant of Sector A and Sector B of the Berlin Defensive District. He committed suicide together with his wife in Berlin with Soviet forces fast approaching just four days later.
