rough but that which is in the voice. As a sign the presupposes both the voice and its removal."⁹ In this context one can legitimately speak of a voice of a text because there is always already the voice in writing. When Gadamer claims that it is "necessary to separate the concept of the word from its grammatical sense,"¹⁰ he is objecting to the removal of the voice from writing. For Gadamer the communicative situation demands that grammarology not exclude the voice.

Thirdly, and finally, in the claim that the voice is of the breath, there is entailed a further claim—and here we return to the issue of the corruption of the voice—that at the edge of breath is memory. We should not forget that in the *Phaedrus* the issue in terms of which the distinction between speaking and writing is raised is the issue of memory. In the myth told by Socrates, Thamus holds against the invention of writing, against the substitution of the breathless sign for the living voice, because it cannot answer for itself. Consequently, writing, as a recipe for reminding rather than memory, will implant forgetfulness in the souls who have learned it. According to Derrida, this myth is meant to instruct us in the danger that Socrates sees in inverting the priority of speaking over writing. In inverting

the priority, one will have turned "from the origin for truth to the origin for falsity."¹¹ In the *Phaedrus*, the myth of Thamus is meant to instruct us in the danger of memory as the field of presence, of the "now," over the other, and the text in a more general sense. In the myth, the question of truth is a question for speaking, not speaking over writing, where writing is understood as the fixation of speech.
