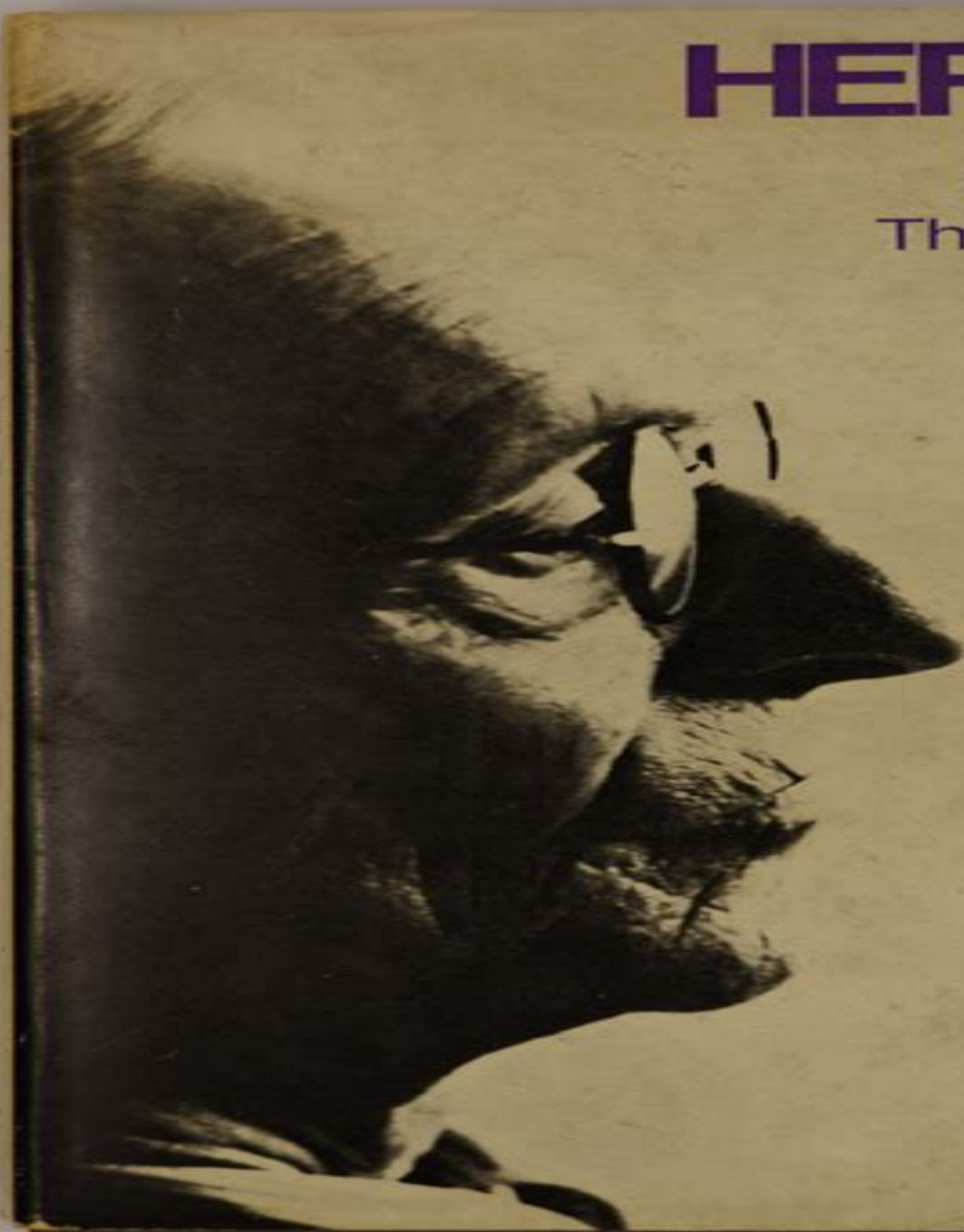

[This Side: Stories](#) Hermann Hesse, In 1907 Hermann Hesse released *Diesseits* a collection of short stories whose title can be translated as *This Side* or *On This Side of Life* Published by S Fischer in Berlin *Diesseits* marked Hesse's return to the short prose form after concentrating on novels The book comprises a series of tales and sketches often labeled *Erzählungen* narratives written in the years following his early

creation of his masterwork *The Decameron* a collection of 100 tales Hesse published this piece anonymously or under commission it was common then for series volumes not to feature the author's name prominently so it did not contribute to his fame in the way his fiction did However the book had its own quiet publishing history it likely appeared as a slim attractive volume aimed at educated readers with an interest in classic authors It might have been part of a larger series on Great Men of Letters which was popular in that era While Boccaccio did not achieve wide circulation in English no widely known English edition exists aside from perhaps later scholarly translations it remains an intriguing example of Hesse working as a literary critic and historian This biographical essay reimagines the Italian Renaissance storyteller as a proto-modernist subverting medieval dogma through irreverent humanism Hesse contrasts Boccaccio's *Decameron* with its celebration of sensual vitality against the asceticism of ecclesiastical tradition framing the Florentine's tales as acts of cultural rebellion The text's exuberant prose mirrors its subject's stylistic audacity while its critique of moral hypocrisy anticipates Hesse's later clashes with authoritarianism Though seldom discussed today Boccaccio illuminates Hesse's enduring fascination with historical liminality eras where collapsing ideologies birth new artistic possibilities The essay's defense of aesthetic pleasure as a counter to institutional repression aligns with Jung's later theories of creative individuation though Hesse's approach remains firmly secular

The Neighbors Hermann Hesse, In this story collection Hesse explores the tensions between communal belonging and individual autonomy The titular story juxtaposes two families one gregarious one reclusive their fraught interactions illuminating the paradoxes of human proximity Published in Berlin the narratives eschew moralizing instead probing the quiet desperations underlying suburban respectability Hesse's 1908 collection *Nachbarn* *Neighbors* continued his exploration of short fiction offering another mosaic of vignettes and tales drawn from daily life Published by S Fischer in Berlin as with his previous story collection this book further solidified Hesse's reputation as a master of the short narrative form The title *Nachbarn* suggests a focus on those who live next door or nearby the people in one's community whom one might see every day and yet only partially know Indeed the stories in *The Neighbors* revolve around interpersonal encounters in small towns and villages shedding light on the hidden dramas and quiet bonds between ordinary folks One can imagine that these narratives were inspired by Hesse's own observations while living in close-knit Gaienhofen as a sensitive artist in a rural community he was well-placed to note the subtle interactions among neighbors friends and strangers passing through The collection much like *Die Leute* did not catapult Hesse to new fame by 1908 he was already a known quantity but it added depth to his body of work Readers of the time would have found in *Nachbarn* a gentle engaging read stories that might start with the simplicity of a neighborly hello and end revealing a profound truth or a twist of fate In the Anglophone world *Nachbarn* as a set has rarely been published independently but some of its stories have been translated in assorted anthologies of Hesse's shorter works *The Neighbors* exemplifies Hesse's growing interest in psychological dualism its
