Parham, 2013-03-09 The Major Histocompatibility Complex MHC was discovered as a consequence of the chronic problem encountered by cancer biologists in the early years of this century the failure to maintain tumor lines by serial passage in outbred mice A number of observations pointed to genetic similarity being a prerequisite for successful transplantation and they were incorporated into a genetic theory of transplantation by C C Little This prompted scientists like Little to initiate breeding experiments designed to test his hypothesis and produce genetically identical mice which would permit the growth of transplanted tumors Most inbred strains of mice commonly used in immunology derive from those efforts Transplantation of normal tissues obeyed the same rules found for malignant tissues and rejection was shown to be an immunological phenomenon G D Snell showed that a single genetic locus determined rapid rejection of skin grafts This was initially called the Major Histocompatibility Locus but was subsequently shown to include many functionally related genes and renamed the Major Histocompatibility Complex MHC In mouse this is the H 2 complex and man the HLA complex During this same period P A

T cell specificity and Cross-reactivity - Implications in Physiology and Pathology Samuele Notarbartolo, Daniela Latorre, Tomasz Piotr Wypych, Silvia Monticelli, Dominik Aschenbrenner, 2024-03-07 Conventional CD8 and CD4 T cells recognize antigens presented by antigen presenting cells in the form of short peptides loaded onto major histocompatibility complex MHC class I and class II molecules through their T cell receptor TCR Somatic gene rearrangement of the TCR locus and randomization of TCR hyper variable regions generate the marked diversity of TCRs Once assembled the heterodimeric TCR confers specificity to na ve T cells The na ve T cell repertoire of an individual is established by selection processes in the thymus and cannot be broadened upon antigen recognition by additional somatic mutations In humans the estimated number of distinct TCRs in the na ve T cell pool is several orders of magnitude lower than the possible array of peptides that can be generated and accommodated into an MHC molecule This challenge can be overcome by T cell cross reactivity that is the ability of a single TCR to bind multiple peptide MHC complexes T cell cross reactivity can have both positive and negative consequences First it allows for covering a wide range of foreign peptides with a limited repertoire of T cells Second it facilitates polyclonal immune responses to a single peptide and increases resistance to escape mutations Third it can induce heterologous immunity that is the generation of memory to a pathogen different from the one against which the immune response has been originally raised On the contrary a negative consequence of T cell cross reactivity is the possibility of self antigen recognition potentially causing autoimmunity The lower activation threshold of memory T cells compared to na ve T cells increases this risk partially eluding the thymic negative selection checkpoint Moreover heterologous immunity can be detrimental when the type of memory T cell polarization induced by the first pathogen is inappropriate to control the second pathogen

Reche, 2025-01-06 There is a growing evidence that cross reactive immunity from common human coronaviruses hCoVs can shape the immunological response to SARS CoV 2 Cross reactive T cells appear to play a protective role against disease but there is no consensus on the role of cross reactive

antibodies with some authors reporting protective effects mechanisms and other authors reporting evidence of negative interference due to the generation of low affinity antibodies in the context of an original antigenic sin Reports of association of pre existing immunity to hCoVs and milder clinical manifestations of COVID 19 conflict with other reports showing in COVID 19 patients a strong back boosting of antibodies to hCoVs with very little if no neutralizing activity against SARS CoV 2 However SARS CoV 2 hCoVs cross reactive antibodies more specifically those directed against the S2 subunit of the Spike protein may be protective via Fc mediated mechanisms that recruits NK cells ADCC or similar mechanisms Since these antibodies do not neutralize or neutralize very poorly SARS CoV 2 in vitro they have been only occasionally investigated and rarely considered in the search for correlates of protection Alternatively it should also be considered that protection against severe COVID 19 disease may be sustained by cross reactive T cells with cross reactive antibodies being only a proxy of protective T cell immunity Although pre existing immunity to SARS CoV 2 is more often linked hCoVs other sources of cross reactive immunity to SARS CoV 2 including bacteria and vaccine antigens are also plausible and should be considered In particular it has been identified first computationally and later experimentally cross reactive immunity to SARS CoV 2 from combination tetanus diphtheria vaccines DTaP DTwP TD and Tdap Moreover epidemiological studies have clearly shown that subjects vaccinated with tetanus diphtheria vaccines are less likely to suffer severe COVID 19 Cross reactive immunity to SARS CoV 2 from pediatric tetanus Diphtheria vaccines and seasonal exposures to hCoVs likely play an important role in protecting children from COVID 19 On the other hand the elderly may fail to mount an effective primary response to SARS CoV 2 following infection owing to the loss of cross reactive memory B and T cells and their relative inability to recruit naive T and B cells
